# C3 Australia finalises new contract

C3 Australia has recently signed a new 12-month contract for the Brisbane Log Marshalling site with our customer HQPlantations. Our C3 AUS and LINX Logistics teams will work together as they aim to export approximately 60,000 Jas of logs within the year for our customer. Overseeing these operations is C3 AUS Log Marshalling Manager – Brisbane QLD, Shannon Yanko.

Our teams will support our customer as they aim to grow the business into new export market opportunities in Korea, Vietnam and India, following the continued trade bans on timber exports into China.

Due to these trade bans, operations were suspended in October 2020. The operations resumed with a reduced workforce and volume in April 2021. Signing this new contract means we look forward to continuing our partnership with HQPlantations.

This lead to discussions with our customer, solutions being made and reducing damage costs for the business.





**Craig Allen - C3 NZ Operations Manager, Masterton** Over a four week period Craig increased rail wagon payload utilisation by 25%, reduced double handling from 100% to 25% in the Waingawa log yard and negotiated a new shift roster without the need of support. Craig continuously brings his positive energy to work, strengthening relationships with our customers and stakeholders.

Max Ritchie - C3 NZ Acting Supervisor, Steel Warehouse Max jumped into the role of acting Supervisor when needed late last year with drive and enthusiasm. Throughout the Christmas period the team received unexpected volume from our customer NZ Steel, significantly increasing workload. Max and her team never missed a shipment due to her dedication and drive to deliver for our customer.

# C3 NZ opens new checkpoint at Port Nelson



Our new checkpoint facility at Port Nelson officially opened its doors in June. The new facility spans more than 1,000 square metres and features three covered checkpoint lanes with C3's COM3TS technology, new AS/NZS 1657 compliant scaling ramps for fall from height protection, a workshop, checkpoint office, staff facilities and a main office.

"We have around 70 people working at this site, all of whom play a crucial role in keeping our customers' export logs moving. This new checkpoint and its great facilities will go a long way in helping C3 to continue to safely deliver an uninterrupted and efficient service for our customers," said C3 Limited and Pedersen Group COO, Gavin Hudson.
