On Wednesday, 10 November we supported *National Ride2Work Day* by encouraging our people across our Australian based sites to ride to work if possible.

We spoke with Group Asset Manager, Adrian Moore about why he cycles to work, his top tips for those planning to ride to work and about our new end-of-trip facilities at our Melbourne office.

How often do you ride to work?

Once a week at the moment, but usually two to three times a week when not in lockdown.

Why did you decide to start riding to work?

For the exercise and enjoyment. It's a lot nicer than sitting in my car in traffic!

What do you enjoy about cycling?

It's a great way to unwind after a big day.

What tips do you have for those keen to start riding to work?

- Start with riding one day per week and build up from there.
- Ride on bike tracks, it is a lot safer.
- If you are riding on the road, pay attention. You might have right of way, but you are still smaller than a car or truck.
- Be organised, take in a change of clothes on the days when you drive or catch public transport - it's a lot easier to commute on the bike with less to carry.



For you, what are the benefits of riding to work?

Riding to work definitely helps with fitness, it doesn't take much longer than driving and by the time you get home you have done your daily exercise.

What's the favourite part of your ride into work?

I get to ride past the Botanical Gardens, the Yarra River and along Gardener's Creek Trail. It makes the ride a lot more relaxing.

If you could cycle anywhere in the world, where would it be?

I previously did some mountain biking in Utah in the USA. I would love to go back and explore the area a bit more.

Have you had a chance to use the end-of-trip facilities in our new Melbourne office yet? If so, what are they like?

The end-of-trip facilities in Melbourne have just been renovated and are really nice. The lockers are big, the bathrooms are new and you can store your bike in a lockable bike cage.

What are the main operations?

We provide motor vehicle processing, storage and distribution for our customers.

How long has your site been operational?

We have occupied our current site since 2001.

How long have you managed Port Adelaide for?

I have been the Operations Manager for around five months now. Prior to this I held a variety of roles, starting my career as yard hand and progressing to Processing Fitter, Supervisor and then National Account Coordinator. This year I celebrated my 30th anniversary with Autocare!
