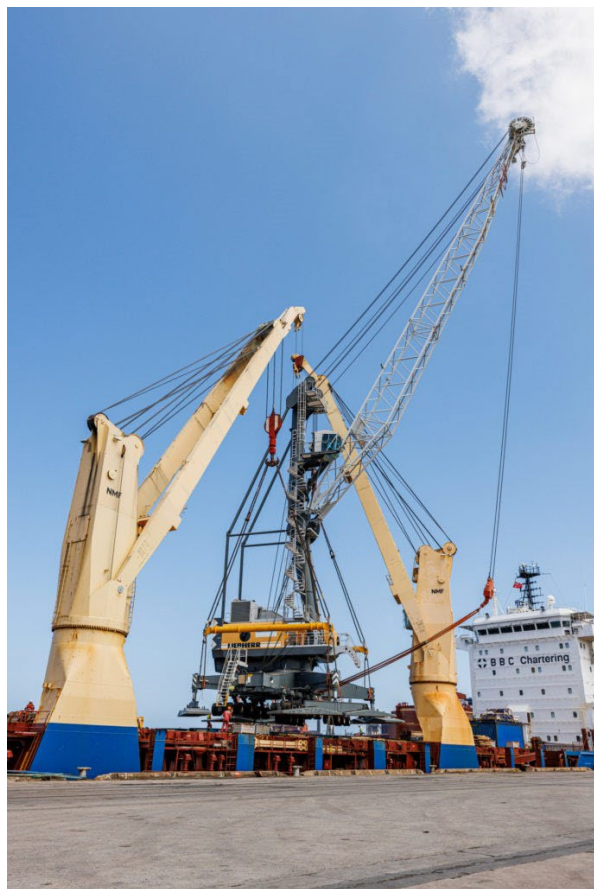

To bolster its capabilities to support our long term customer Bluescope, recently our LINX team in Port Kembla welcomed a Liebherr LHM420 nicknamed 'Hendo' to the team.

Hendo towers 33 metres high, weighs 350 tonne, has a max boom height of 68 metres and is capable of loading up to 60 tonne of steel products in a single lift.

“The relocation of a crane this size is logistically significant however the extra loading and unloading capacity this crane provides, and the broader benefit it will deliver to a crucial part of BlueScope’s operation, made it an easy decision and well worth the effort,” said Vince Trotter, Executive General Manager, LINX Port Services.

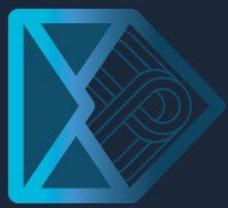

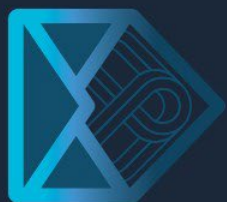


The Great Nundle Dog Race

The competition raises crucial funds to support the local club.

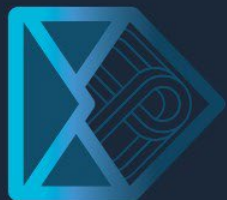
Burnie Emus kick off the 2022 season
