Pedersen Group unveils state-of-the-art export log Debarker facility



Showcasing world class innovation, Pedersen Group recently unveiled its new Nicholson A5 Series High Speed 35" Tandem Ring Debarker plant at its Kinleith, Tokoroa site in New Zealand.

The efficient and precise machine removes the need for manual debarking - a costly and time consuming process not suitable for such large volumes.

When logs are fed through the Debarker, high-speed swing arm knives scrape off the bark, removing the threat of insect pests.

The new plant boasts an impressive annual capacity of 600,000 tonnes.
